



**PARSOL Regulatory Stream Delivers “Scores on the Doors” Module

We are delighted to announce the release of the REGALION “**Scores on the Doors**” module in support of the initiative to publish ratings from programmed Food Safety/Hygiene Inspections. The SOTD initiative is backed by the Food Standards Agency, CIEH, LACORS and Which?

Scores on the Doors provides a configurable public register of food hygiene ratings derived from the FSA’ Food Hygiene Scores following a programmed inspection. The solution also enables authorities to obtain a self service response to food safety related requests under the Freedom of Information Act and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004. There isn’t a national standard for publishing ratings, as yet, and the Food Standards Agency are monitoring a number of regional pilots with the potential for the introduction of a national standard in the future. The **REGALION (Regulation and Licensing Online) Scores on the Doors** solution enables registers to be published using all the major pilot schemes including

- The pan-London rating mechanism developed with CIEH and Which?
- The “Smile Safe” scheme being piloted in the East Midlands
- The Scottish Food Hygiene Information System
- The Compliance Curve algorithm
- Other ratings mechanisms based on the FSA food hygiene scores

In the event that FSA introduce a national ratings mechanism based on the food hygiene scores that differs from your local ratings mechanism, the **Regalion Scores on the Doors** solution will enable the publication of the register to those standards through a simple change of configuration.

Regalion Scores on the Doors also provides the Food Safety Self Assessment from the **Business Self Assessment** module. This enables businesses to proactively assess their likely level of compliance with the option to action any

recommendations in advance of the next programmed inspection, thereby encouraging proactive monitoring and improvement of food hygiene.

Features of the Regalion “Scores on the Doors” solution include

- Facility to load data for existing inspection scores
- User interface to allow outcomes of individual inspections to be recorded
- Calculation of the ratings against all major SOTD pilot initiatives
- Branded access to your authority’s Scores on the Doors Service, individually and regionally, with links to the relevant authority contacts
- Automated publication of the Register against a chosen rating mechanism with published explanations for the citizen
- Search of the Register
- Sorting of the Register
- Mapping of premises on the register including travel directions
- Business Self Assessment
- Scores on the Doors has been designed to be enabled integration with other modules across the REGALION solution suite.
- XML schema for collection of inspection data. The schema are openly published and where appropriate, conform to existing govTalk schema ensuring consistency and interoperability
